1. Required Files

2. Install files

Depending on your windows OS the files are then copied into:

For Windows 32 bit - C:\Windows\system32

For Windows 64 bit - C:\Windows\SysWOW64 - this will be used as the example

3. Registering DLL

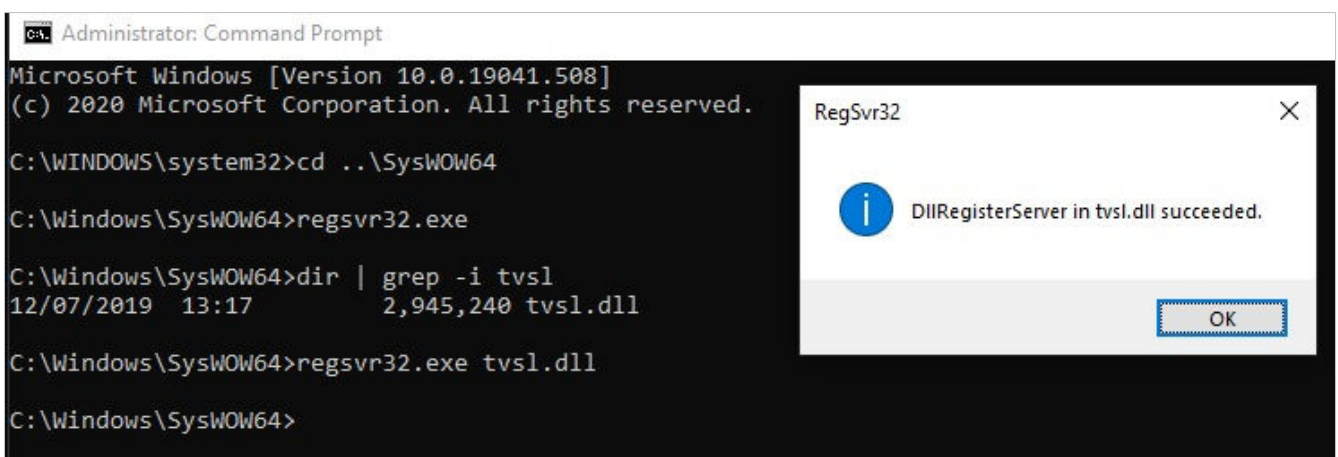
Open the command prompt (DOS windows) with administrative privileges

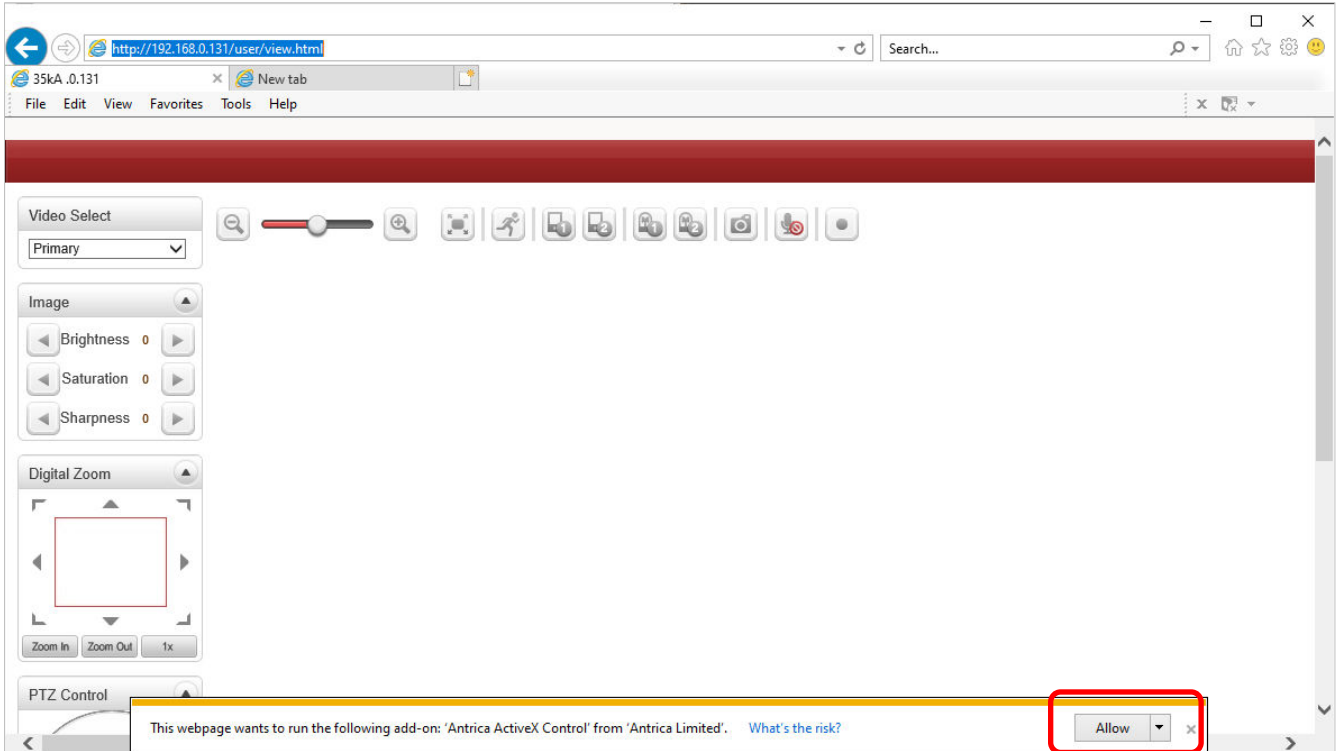
Figure 1 : Registering DLL

Navigate to the require folder, see the example in Figure 1.

Run the command `regsvr32.exe tvsl.dll`

If successfully the "RegSvr32" pop-up windows will appear with the message "DllRegisterServer in tvsl.dll succeeded", as shown in Figure 1.

4. Using ActiveX

When Internet Explorer is used to view the webpage of the Antrica product, the Run ActiveX message is see, as show as the bottom of Figure 2. This is not an install ActiveX request, but asking for permission to use the plugin.

5. TVSL.DLL versions

5.1. Find installed version

To determine the version installed open Internet Explorer and got to the “tools”, then “Managed Add-ons” as shown in Figure 3.

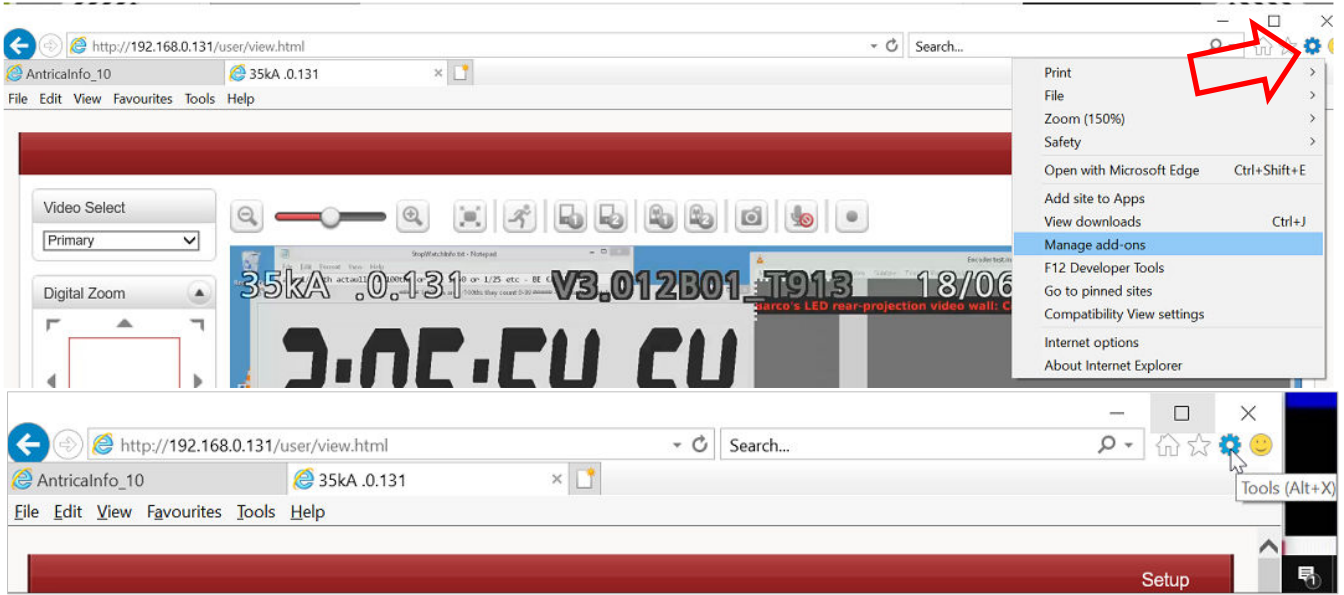


Figure 4 : Internet Explorer – list of installed Add-ons

A pop-up windows will appear. Search that list to find the Antrica Limited “TVSLiveControl Class”, as shown in Figure 4. The version and date can be seen.

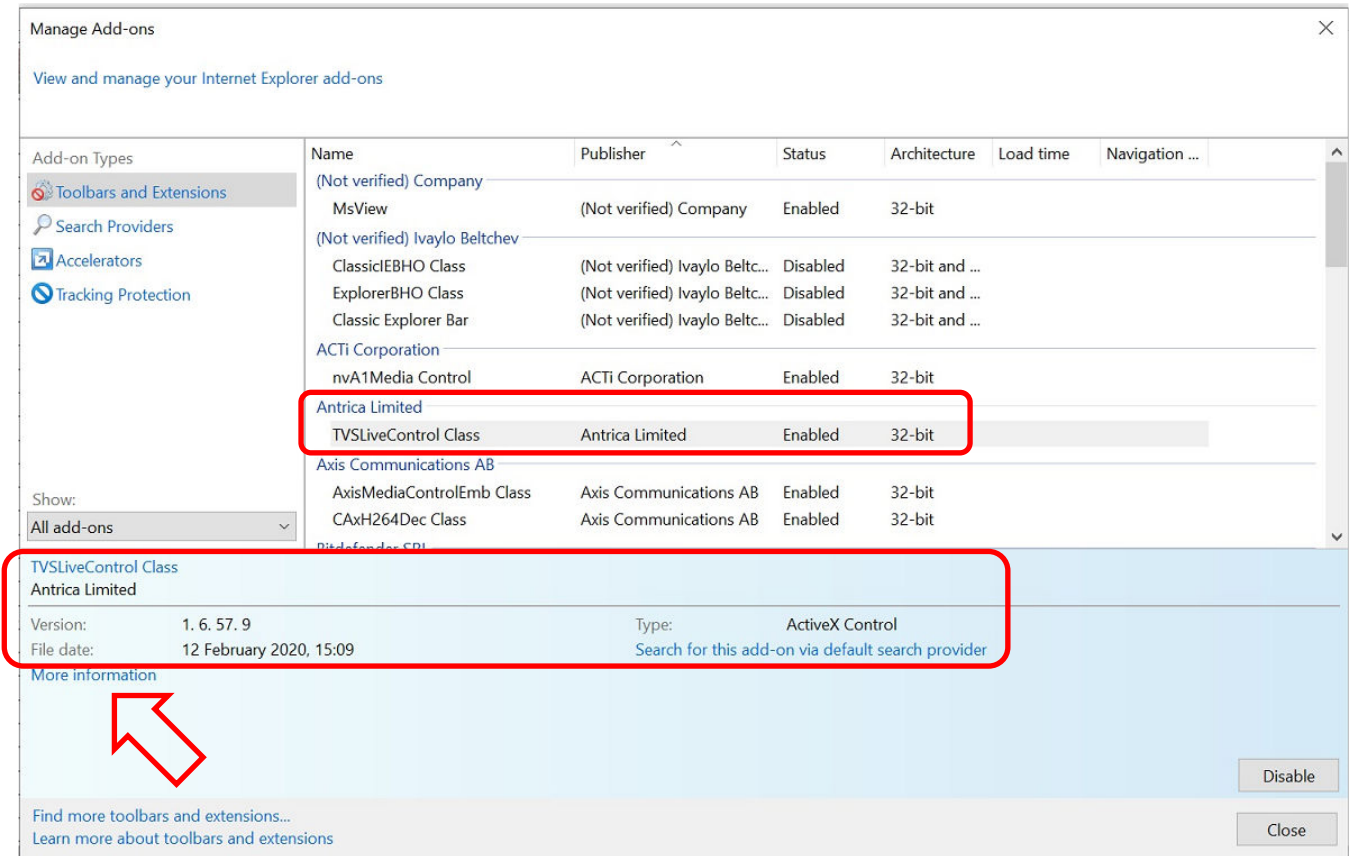
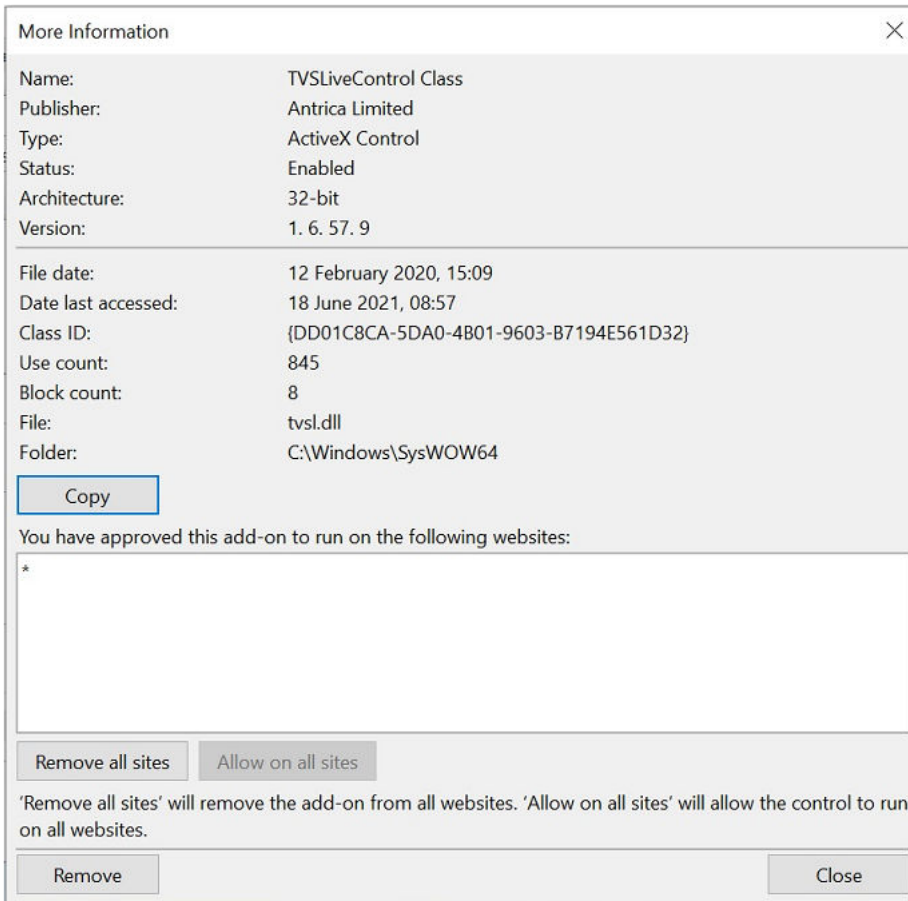


Figure 5 : Internet Explorer – detail about Add-ons

If the “More Information” is clicked a new pop-up windows appears, as shown in Figure 5, with additional information about the Add-on.

Figure 3 : Internet Explorer Settings

5.3. To change / update the DLL

To update the DLL

1. Unregister the DLL, from command prompt (DOS windows) with administrative privileges
run: `regsvr32.exe /u tvsl.dll`
2. Replace the tvsl.dll file with the new one
3. register the DLL, from command prompt (DOS windows) with administrative privileges run:
`regsvr32.exe tvsl.dll`

NOTE: If the installed DLL version is less than the required version by the Antrica product, you will see the install request, as shown in Figure 6. This is where the addition tvsl.dll, as mentioned in "5.2 DLL locations", maybe required.
